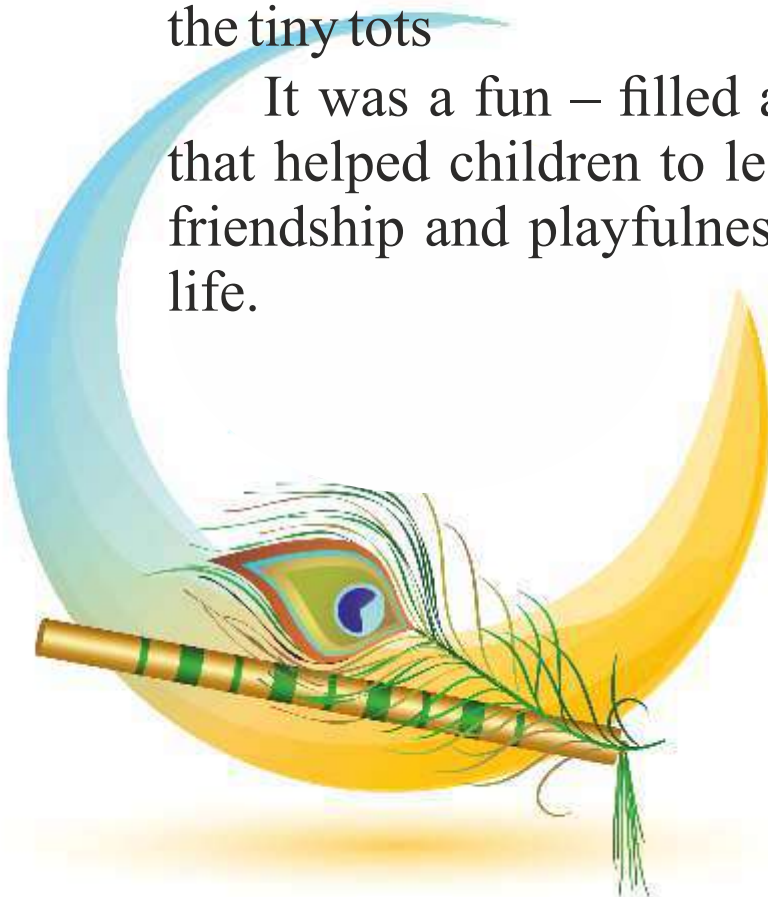




Krishna Leela – Joyful steps of little Kanhas

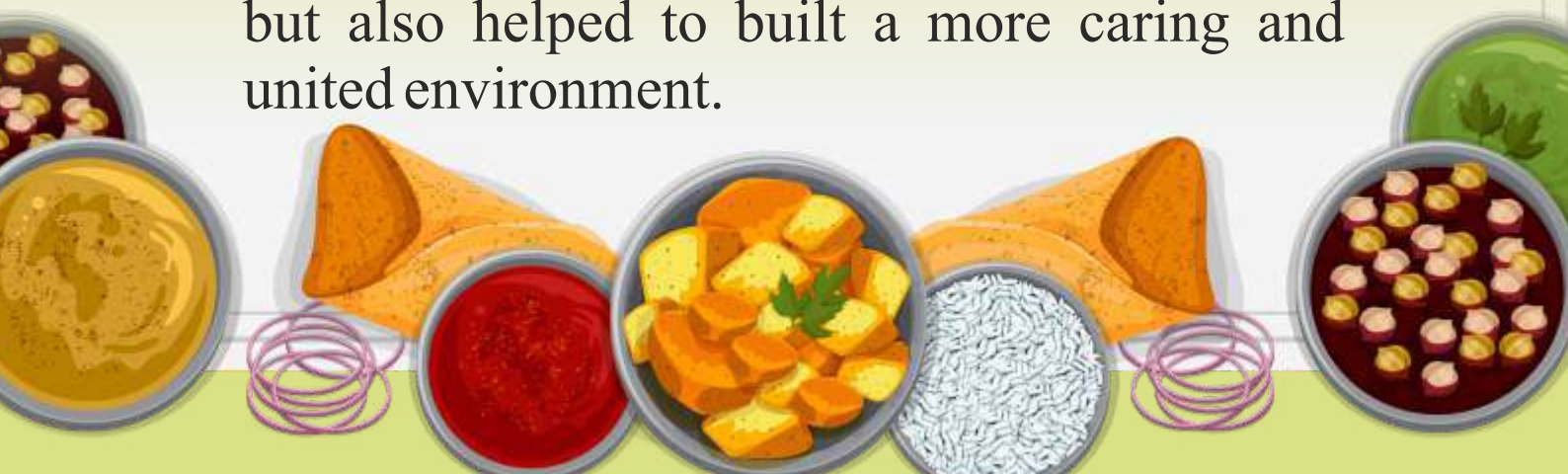
The Gift of Giving


Trash To Treasure
