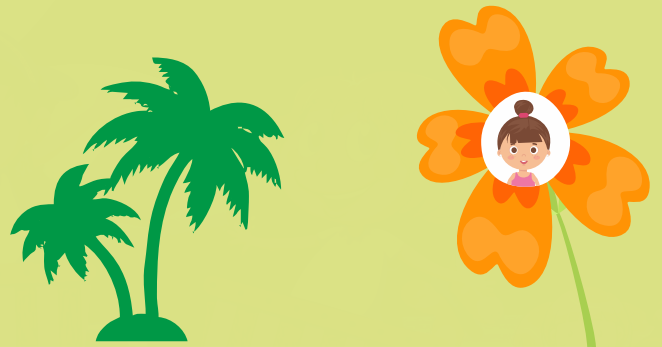
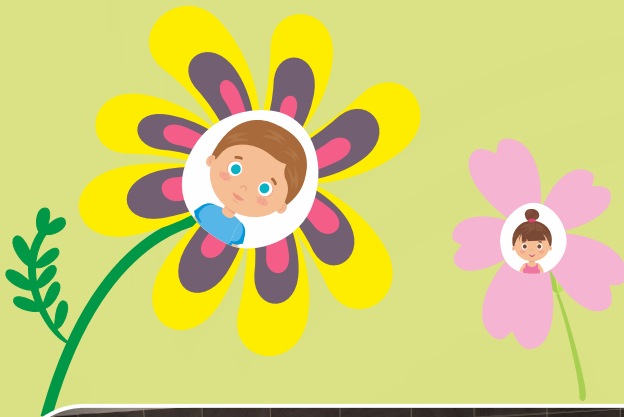
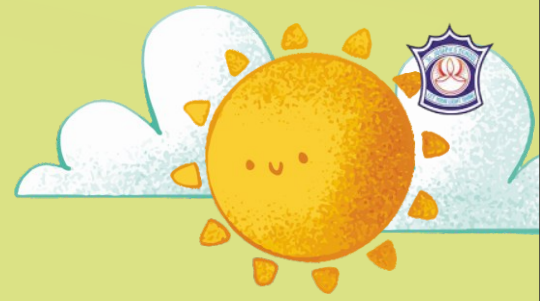

“Little hands can hold big dreams when guided with love.”

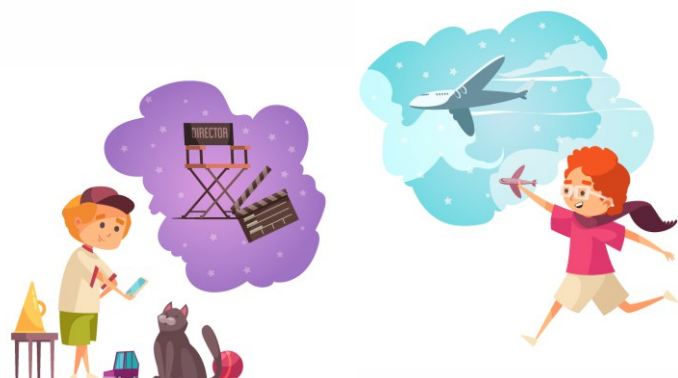

Discipline with love in Kindergarten

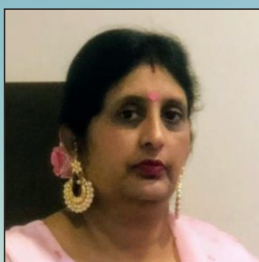
Discipline in Kindergarten is not about strict rules or punishment, it is about guiding little hearts with love and patience. Young children learn best when they feel safe, cared for and understood.

Educators instructed the children to bring paper twine and diverse ornamental supplies.

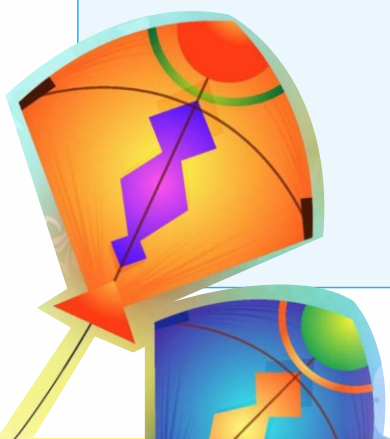
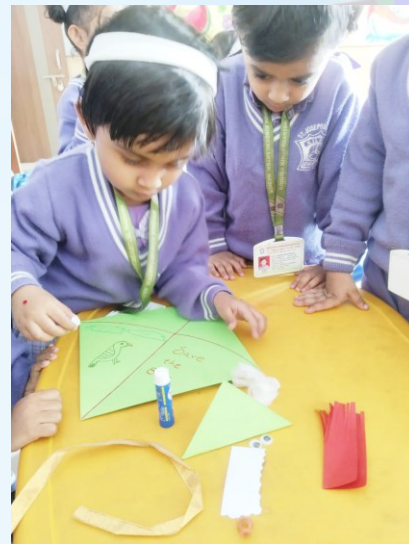

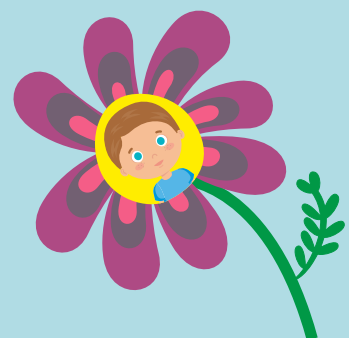
Reading is the seed of knowledge. Writing helps children to express their thoughts. Play helps children think and share.

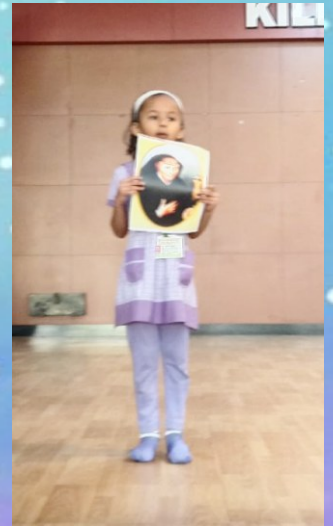

All feelings such as happiness, sadness, anger, fear, excitement are normal. There are no “bad” feelings. We need to understand and manage our feelings well.

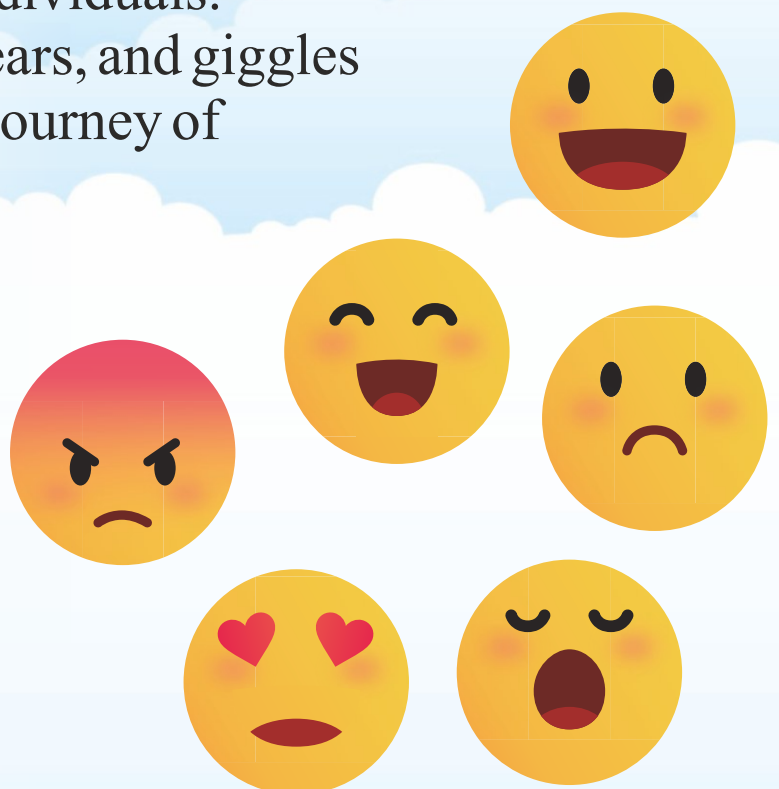
Understanding and dealing with feelings and emotions play a significant role in early childhood education.

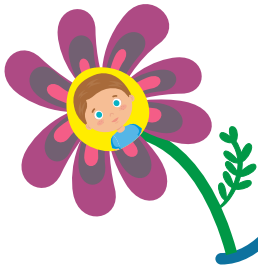
