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WHY ARE SOME PEOPLE LEFTHANDED

About 4% of the population is left handed . in the course of history, many of the greatest geniuses have been also left handed . Leonardo da Vinci and Michelangelo, the greatest sculptures of all times, were both left handed . the brain has a right half and a left half, and thus to do not function in the same way. it is believed that the left of the brain is predominant over the right half . this being the case, the right half of the body is more skilled and better able to do things. we read ,write ,speak and work with the left half of the brain. and this, of course, makes most of us right handed too. but in the case of left-handed people, it was the other way around. the right half of the brain is predominant, and search a person works best with the left side of his body.

Do elephants never forget?

To have a good memory you need to have big brain. Elephants have the largest brain of any land animal. An adult male African elephant's brain weighs about 5,000 grams, while an adult human's brain weight about 1400 grams. Elephants use their memories to survive. Their great size means they need large quantities of food and water. They must remember where these resources can be found at certain Times Of The Year. Elephants use 'paths' to remember how to reach their food sources. Herds follow this Paths for generations. In Arunachal Pradesh, during the 1950's a house was built over an Elephant's Path. Every year, the people who lived in the house had to fight off doesn't dozens of elephants that tried to walk right through the walls. One year, the elephant actually knocked the House Down to reach and access to their Path Studies have shown at elephants can remember human beings to that can recognize and individual person by our sight or by scent given when they have not met for decades. There is even evidence that elephants can be a grudge against people!

How can ants carry so much weight in proportion to their size?

The reason why ants can lift so much weight is because of scaling. Ant muscles are not longer in human muscles own pull – for –pull basis, but ants' small size gives them an advantage on how much muscle force they can produce. A muscle is basically a bundle of fibers which can contract and create a pulling force. The amount of force produced by a muscle is proportional to the cross-sectional area of that bundle of fibers. With humans and their bicep, the bigger the, larger the cross –sectional area, and the more force or strength that can be applied by it. So, the reason ants can lift so much because of their small size means they don't have a large body mass to carry around. Instead, they have proportionately more muscles. Humans on the other hand are proportionally more massive and have less muscles that can be applied to lift heavy things

Where there is a road there is an ST bus!

The Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation abbreviated as MSRTC or simply called ST (state transport) is a state run bus service for transportation across Maharashtra and neighboring states. Though the buses are defamed by the name *lal dabba* because of old buses, dusty interiors, torn seats, emitting visible emissions but it connects the smallest villages to towns and cities.

The service was started in 1948 as Bombay State Road Transport Corporation but it was renamed after the reorganization of the state in 1960. The buses then used 10 makes namely Chevrolet, Ford, Bedford, Seddan, Studebaker, Morris commercial, Albion, Leyland, Coomer and Fiat.



Early MSRTC bus on Leyland chassis

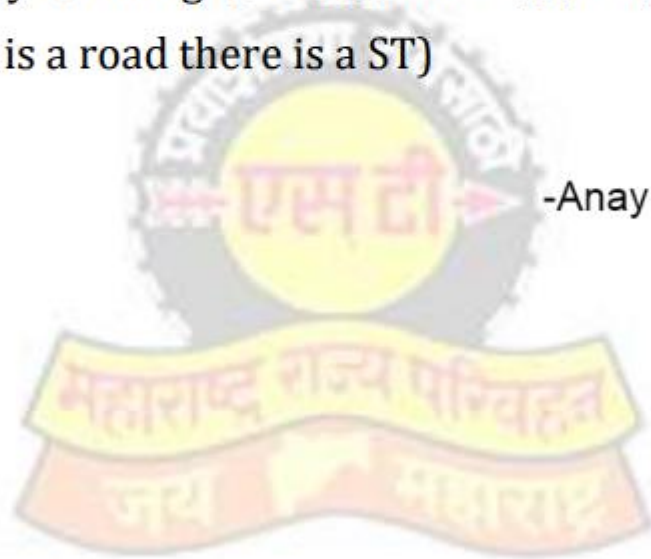
The first bus was flagged off from Pune to Ahmednagar in 1948. The corporation today has 18,449 busses with 1,02,00 employees. ST not only transports passengers but also delivers postal mail, distributes medicines, newspapers and much more.

today's busses are made using the chassis of Ashok Leyland and Tata Motors in the workshop of Dapoli, Aurangabad and Nagpur. ST has variety of busses like Ordinary, Parivartan, Asiad, Hirkani, Shivneri, Shivshahi and the newly added Vithai busses in their fleet.

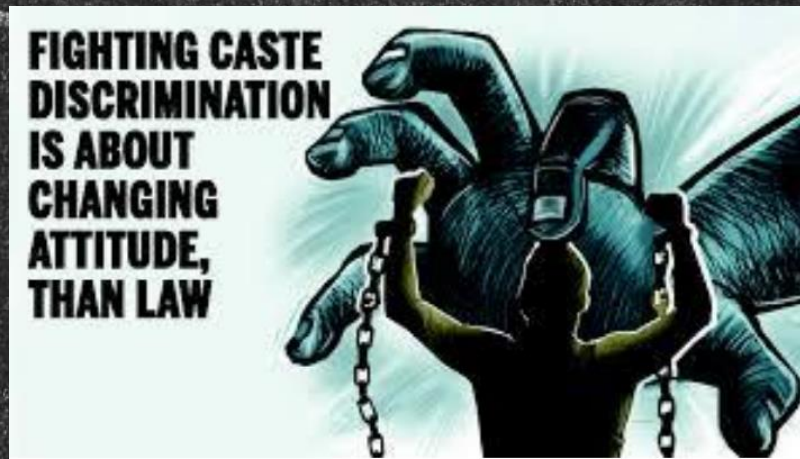

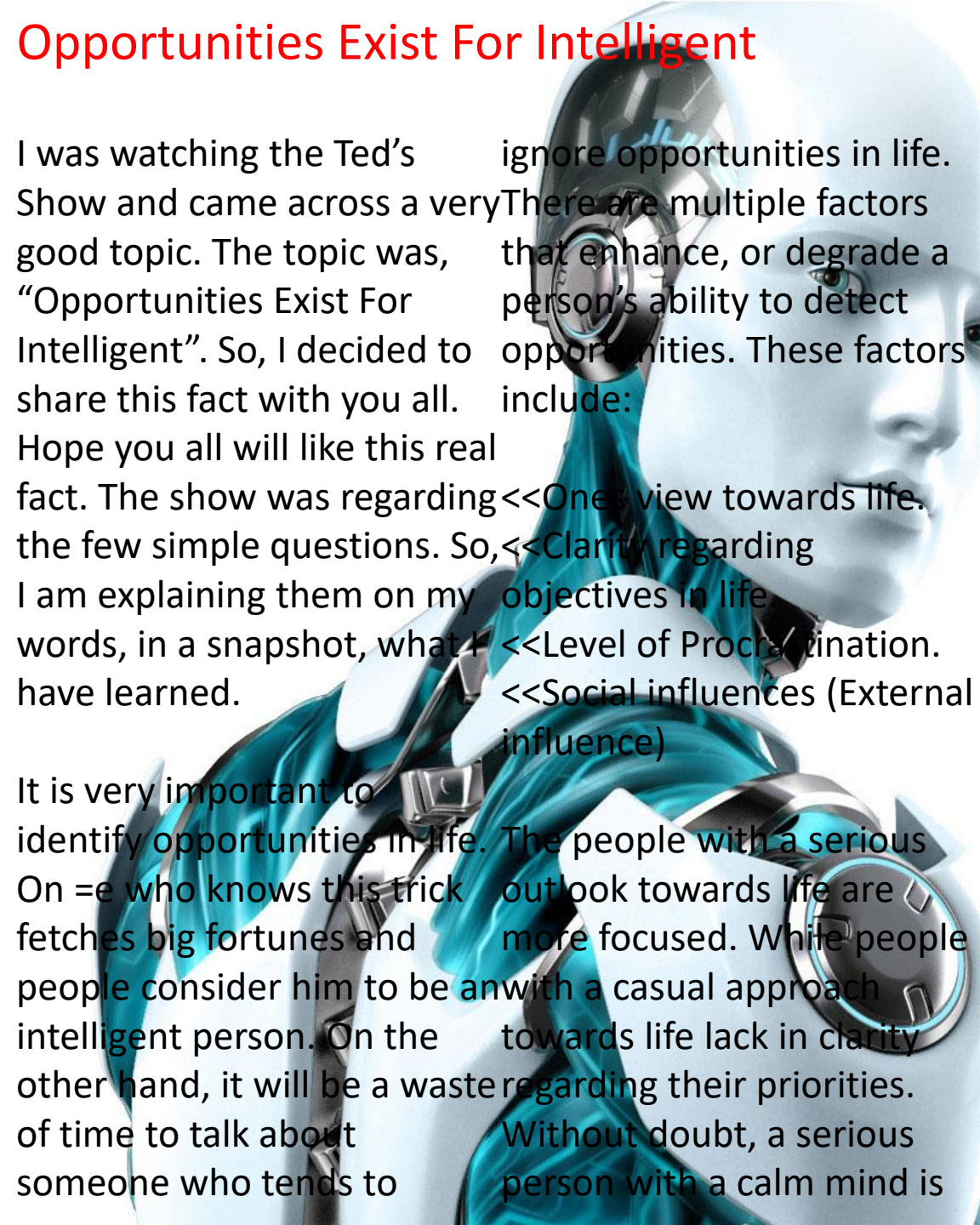

better equipped for success in comparison to a casual dude.

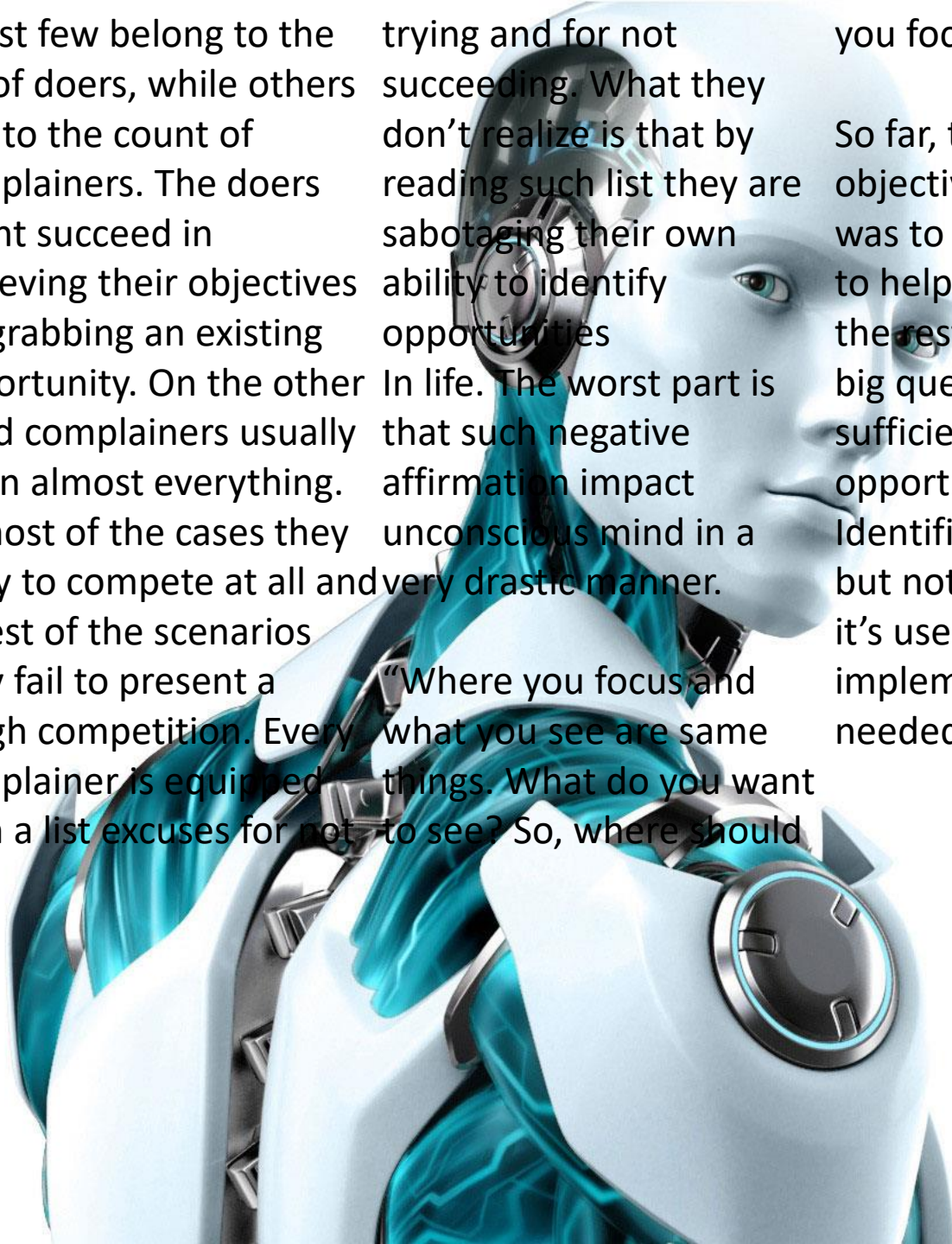
"Your outfit can, but you cannot be casual in order to succeed in life"

Popeye's Spinach Secret

One cartoon character, with his distinctive features, that always impressed and amused all kids is 'Popeye' ! Popeye – wisecracking cartoon sailor who smokes pipe and gains superhuman strengths after having a can of spinach which he always carries with him . Popeye was created by Elzie Chrysler Segar, who introduced Popeye through his existing cartoon strip 'Thimble Theatre'. Popeye with his odd accent and stout arms used spinach to a great effect, as if a sort of steroid. What is the reason behind this?

The truth dates back to 1870, when Eric Von Wolf a German chemist, examined the amount of iron in spinach, among many other green vegetables. While transcribing his data from his notebook to his records, he misplaced the decimal point . As a result, the amount of iron in 100 grams of spinach changed from 3.5 milligrams to 35 milligrams!

Once this incorrect numbers were printed, spinach's nutritional value became legendary. So when Popeye was created, studio executives recommended he eat spinach for his strength, due to its health properties. Apparently Popeye increased American spinach consumption by a third!

The error was eventually corrected in 1937, when someone rechecked the numbers. But the error was so widespread that the British Medical Journal published in 1981, trying its best to finally debunk the issue.

First comes non teaching staff and here is our Deepak

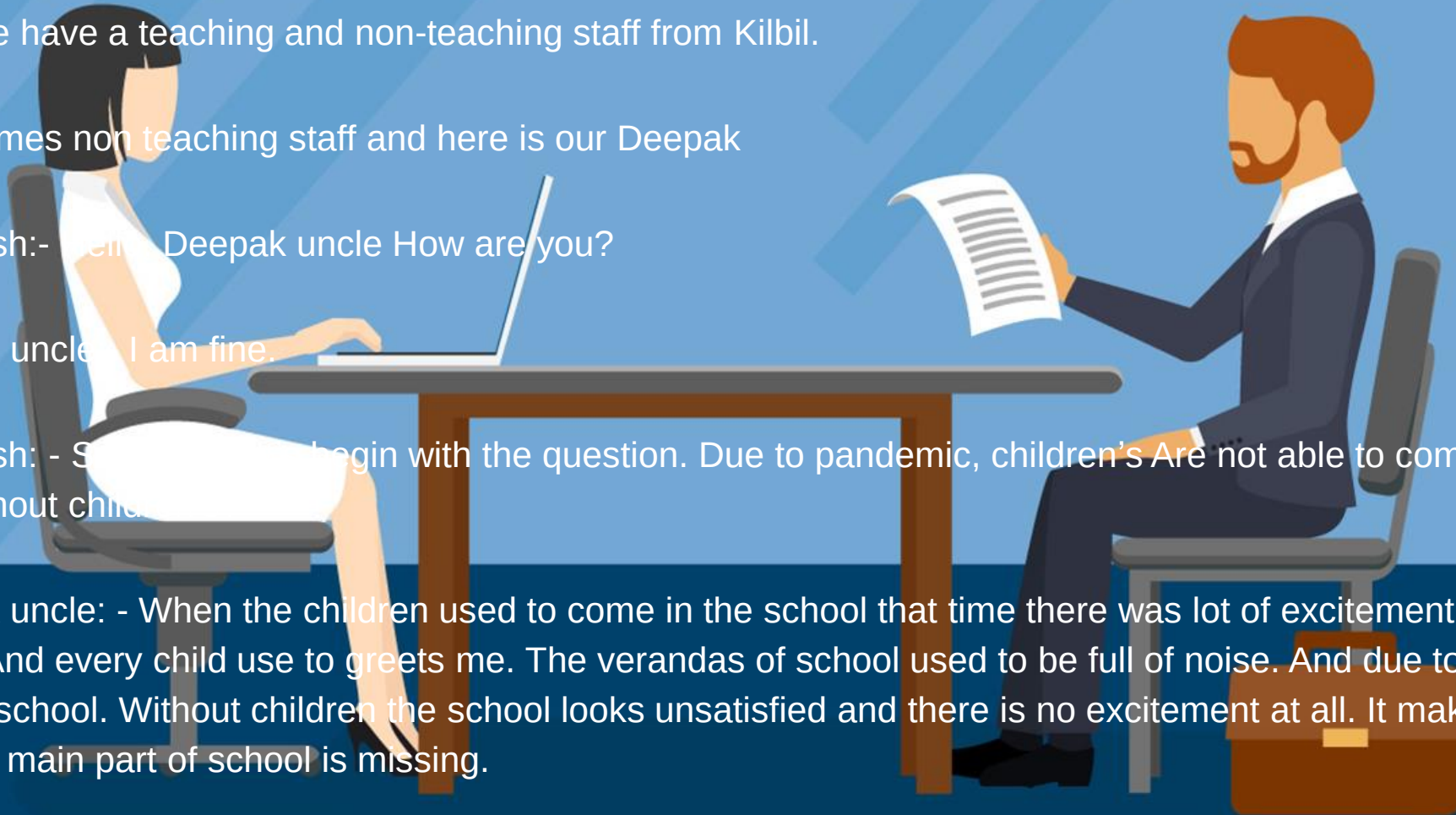
Shreyash:- Hello Deepak uncle How are you?

Now comes from the teaching staff and here is our Rishikesh sir (sports teacher of Kilbil.)

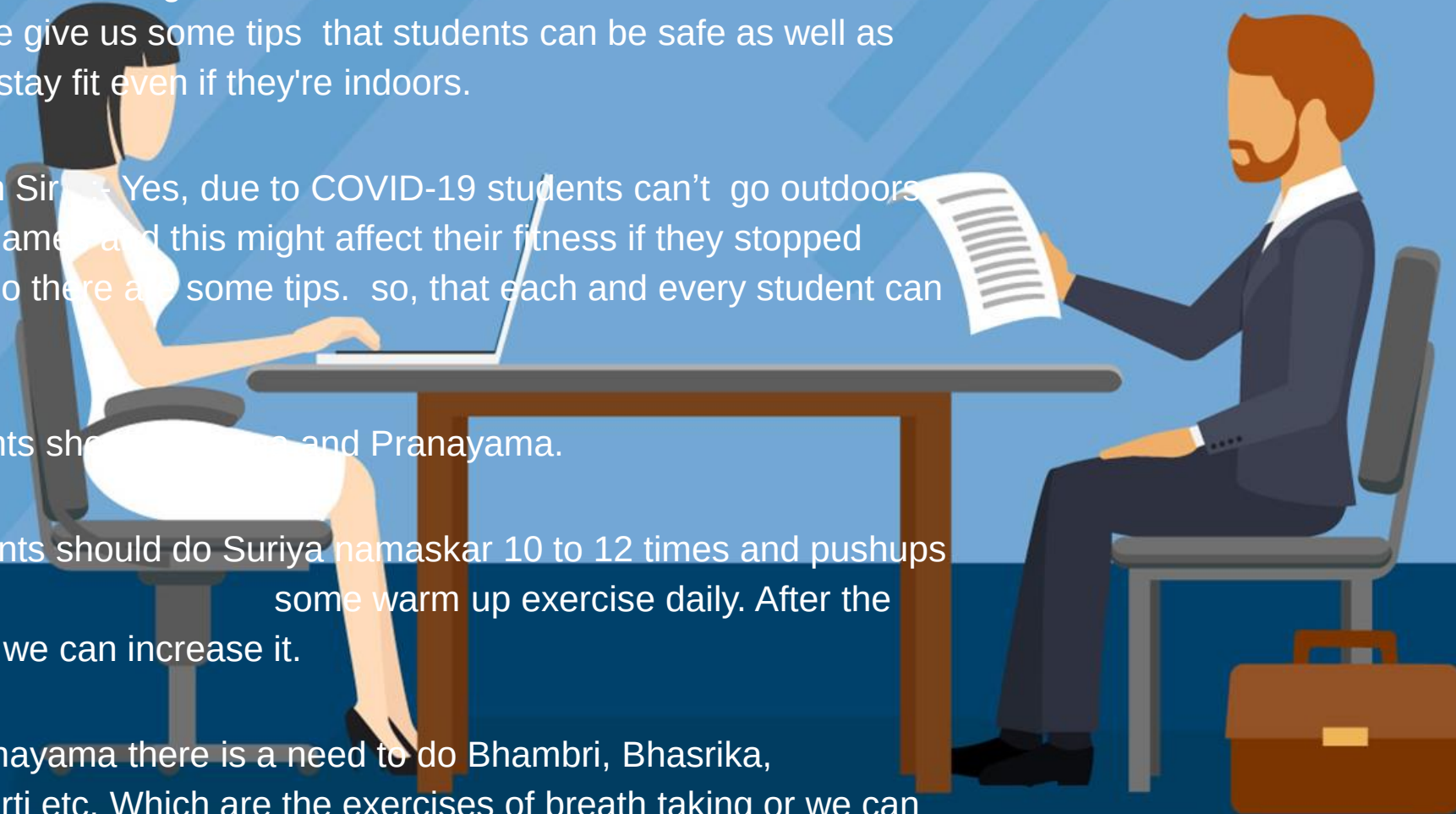

“DUTY TOWARDS HUMANITY”

‘NOT EVERY HERO WEARS A CAPE, SOME WEAR AN APRON AND A HAT’

CHEF HEMANT OBEROI, who risked his life to save dozens of guests at ‘TAJ MAHAL PALACE HOTEL’ during the 26/11 years since the deadliest terror attack shook the nation, and its memories still echo in people’s hearts and minds.....

In an interview with */ANS*, OBEROI, who was head chef of the five-star hotel that time, recounted the brutal incident, sharing the lessons he learnt from the tragedy.

They were busy working in the kitchen. One of the chefs came to him and said that a shooting is going on. We thought a film’s shoot was going on at the hotel but then he realised it was a terror attack. Instead of panicking, he gathered his staff and immediately told them to switch off the lights in the area and lock the doors. That’s what they did to rescue their guests.

For Oberoi, it was not a ‘HEROIC ACT’. According to chef Hemant, he was ‘DOING HIS DUTY TO SERVE HIS GUESTS’. ” He simply believed in ‘ATITHI DEVO BHAVA’, ‘GUESTS ARE LIKE GOD’. To save the guests they were taking decisions each minute as every moment was different. For them, it was not just about heroism, they were just doing their “DUTY TOWARDS HUMANITY.”

In 2008, 10 Pakistani terrorist belonging to LASHKAR-E-TAYIBA sneaked into Mumbai and gunned down over 160 people. Over the course of their attack, 9 of them were killed while one – MOHAMMED AJMAL KASAB was arrested and finally hanged to death in November 2012. Not only the TAJ PALACE but the other City hubs were destroyed, Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus Railway Station, Cafe Leopold, Cama and Alibless Hospital, Nariman House and Oberoi-Trident Hotel. This incident made them so strong and it too changed their perspective towards life. After this incident, Oberoi and his whole management decided to unite and reopen the hotel in 20 – odd days. Oberoi said, “THE ENTIRE RESTUARANT WAS DESTROYED BUT OUR TEAM WORKED VERY WELL AND BROUGHT EVERYTHING BACK.”

OBEROI gives tribute to his colleagues, who laid down the life for others, to victims and their families. He is proud of them and wants to give a SALUTE. Oberoi said, “URGING PEOPLE TO ALWAYS HELP EACH OTHER.”

I SALUTE SUCH A COURAGEOUS PERSONALITY WHO JUST NOT DID HIS DUTY TOWARDS THE NATION BUT ALSO TOWARDS HUMANITY. HE TOO TAUGHT THE VALUE OF ‘ATITHI DEVO BHAVA’, WHICH MEANS, ‘GUESTS ARE LIKE GOD’.

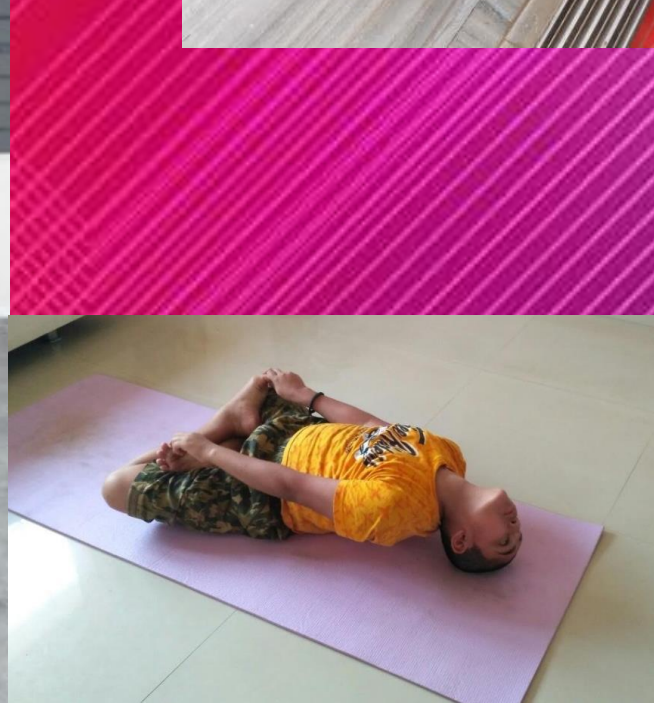

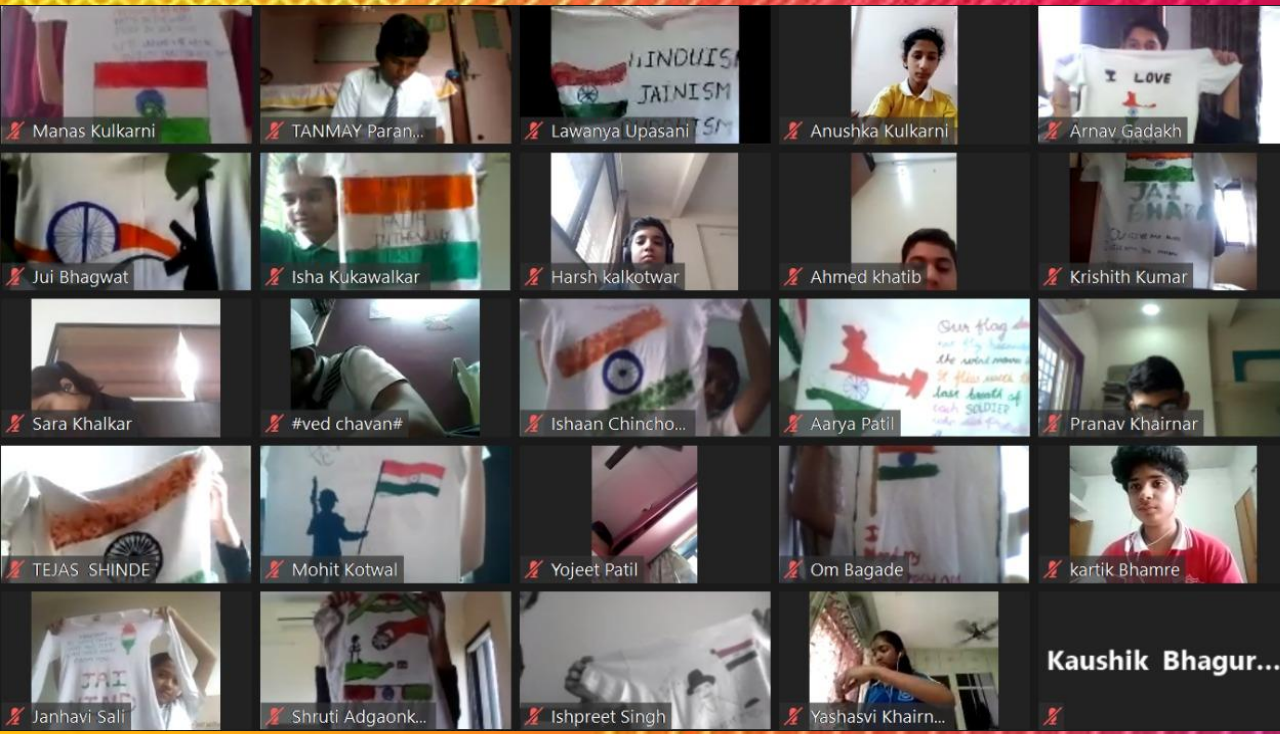
