Generation Gap : A Challenge



A generation gap can be defined as the differences in opinions and ideologies of people belonging from different generations. In today's world, things are rapidly changing, which leads to the coping problem for older generation with new ideologies, as they cannot update themselves like the newer generations due to fixity of thoughts. The new generations also feel left out in confusion when the older generation surrounds them as they find it challenging to keep track of what they are saying. The generation gap is creating a significant relationship problem amongst parents and children. Differences in thought process, opinions, views and ideologies have played an active role in creating a generation gap. The most troubling relationship due to this generation gap is the child-parent relationship.

It has been observed that both the parents and the children have stopped relating with each other. This leads to feeling at both sides that 'I am not understood'. The story of Bermuda Triangle actually began 56 years ago, in 1964. The name of this mysterious place was first used and also actually given by Vincent Gaddis.



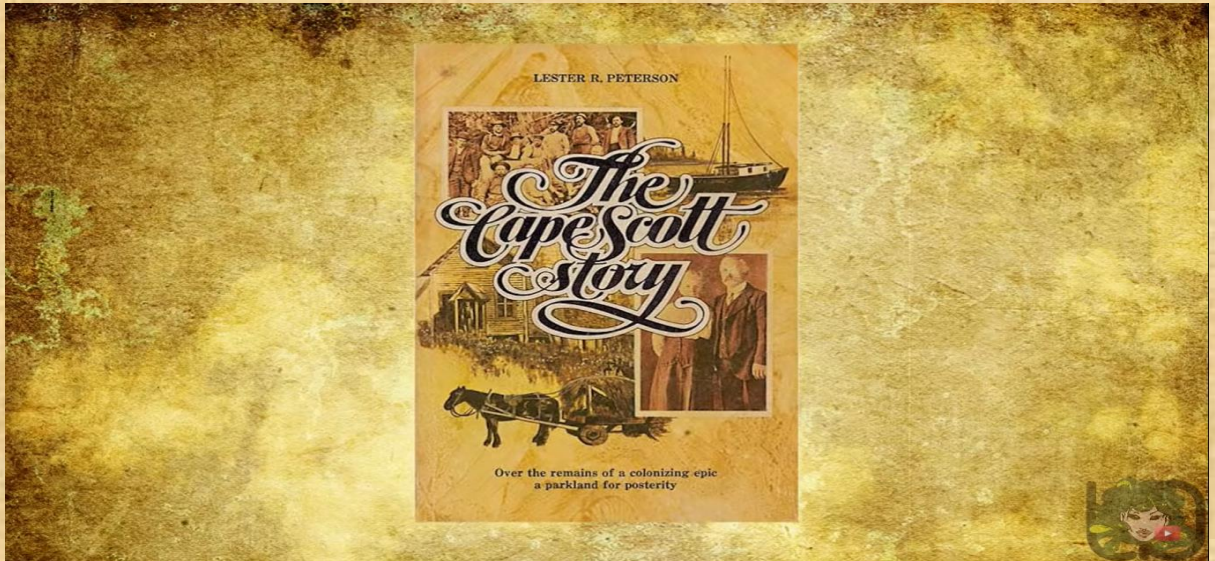

THE BURMUDA TRIANGLE



The Bermuda Triangle, also known as the Devil's Triangle or Hurricane Alley, is a loosely defined region in the western part of the North Atlantic Ocean where a number of aircraft and ships are said to have disappeared under mysterious circumstances. Most reputable source dismiss the idea that there is any mystery.



The vicinity of the Bermuda Triangle is amongst the most heavily traveled shipping lanes in the world, with ships frequently crossing through it for ports in the Americas, Europe and the Caribbean islands. Cruise ships and pleasure craft regularly sail through the region, and commercial and private aircraft routinely fly over it. All 14 airmen on the flight were lost, as were all 13 crew members of a Martin PBM Mariner flying boat that subsequently launched from Naval Air Station Banana River to search for Flight 19.

आपण भारत देशात राहतो. आपल्याकडे विविध जाती- धर्म व पंथाचे लोक राहतात. त्यामुळे आपण जन्माला येतो तेव्हाच या घटकांशी जोडले जातो. समाजातील या व्यवस्था मानवाने निर्माण केलेल्या आहेत. वर्षानुवर्षे त्या परंपरेने चालत आलेल्या असून त्यात कुठलाही बदल झालेला नाही किंवा समाजालाही करावसा वाटलेला नाही.
